Qualifications of Candidates and Nominators

A candidate for State Officer must be:

- a Financial Industrial Member of the New South Wales Local Government, Clerical, Administrative, Energy, Airlines & Utilities Union on 22 February 2021; and
- a Financial Industrial Member of the Branch to which the State Office relates on 22 February 2021; and
- have continuously been a Financial Industrial Member of the New South Wales Local Government, Clerical, Administrative, Energy, Airlines & Utilities Union for 12 months prior to 22 February 2021; and
- be nominated by another two (2) Financial Industrial Members of the Branch to which the State Office relates who are entitled to vote in an election for the State Office concerned.

Ballot and Roll

If, by the close of nominations in an election, the number of persons who have been nominated as candidates in that election does not exceed the number of persons to be elected in that election, each of those persons will be declared elected.

If, by the close of nominations in an election, the number of persons who have been nominated as candidates in the election exceeds the number of persons to be elected in that election, then a ballot for that election will be held.

Where a ballot is held in relation to an election, the:

- roll of voters entitled to vote in that election closed on 23 January 2021; and
- ballot will be open for 21 days.
