Re: Negotiation of new Enterprise Agreement (EA)

The United Services Union refers to correspondence addressed to Mark Sinclair, dated 4th March 2021 informing your organisation of our intention to commence negotiation of a new EA at Teachers Federation Health (TFH).

As you are aware, the Teachers Federation Health Ltd Enterprise Agreement & NSW Clerical and Administrative Employees Enterprise Agreement 2017 – 2021 has recently expired on the 30th of June 2021.

The United Services Union (USU) has actively been in consultation with our membership, who have expressed a strong desire to commence negotiations for a new Agreement.

In facilitation of the 'Good Faith' Bargaining protocols and in preparation of negotiations, we request information on the following:

- Breakdown of total number of employees of TFH.
- Breakdown of total number of employees currently covered by the TFH EA.
- Breakdown of all employee classifications, including both EA and non-EA employees.
